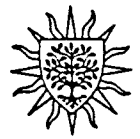

SPECIAL NOTE:

Our Club has taken on a great responsibility, in that The Anderson Chapter has been given special permission to reprint "The Traditions and History of Anderson County" by Louise Ayer Vandiver, which was published only in 1928, in time for the Anderson County Centennial.

In order to get the initial money needed to publish, we have contacted some local businesses in the area requesting their support. Some have responded by sending contributions, but we are still a long way from getting the money needed to complete this project. One idea for raising money, was to have a pre-publication order. The book upon completion will sell for \$25.00, while ordering before publication, the same book will cost \$18.00. Also, we have added an index that the original one does not have. The indexing is another of our Club's projects. We are very excited about this re-printing because of the invaluable information found about early Anderson County families found in this area in the late eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries. While some of the early families continued living here, many moved to other states such as; GA, AL, TN, TX, and etc.
