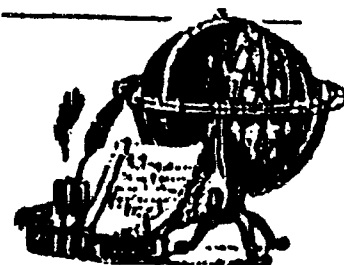

Excerpts from History

A long line of Kings and Scottish nobles had ruled Scotland until 1703. The final agreement to the union of the two countries was completed in 1707. When the Norman invasion of England took place in 1066 AD, displaced people from Northumberland were allowed to settle in southern Scotland. The reformation had made basic changes. Economic changes were taking place that made a difference. A large group of Catholic people living in the highlands of Scotland and a smaller number in England and Ireland did not accept the merger. They claimed James Edward Stuart to be the rightful heir of the throne of Scotland and England. They were called Jacobites since this was the Latin name for James.

The first Jacobite rebellion began in 1715. James Edward Stuart had lived in exile in France for most of his life. In November 1715 he slipped into Scotland and soon had a small army for his support. Three battles were fought and lost in a short period. The Jacobites were not well organized or well supported. In November 1715 they marched into Preston on the west central coast of England and proclaimed James Edward to be their rightful King. Two days later government troops met them there in battle. The Jacobites lost the battle and two of their leaders were hanged. A third one was imprisoned in the Tower of London. On the night before he was to be executed his wife smuggled a set of her close into him. He dressed up as a cleaning woman and escaped. According several accounts 639 soldiers were captured and sentenced to "transportation" which meant that they were sent to America. There is some question about the fate of three of them. The records indicate that 637 were sent to America early in 1716. All agreed to be sold as indentured servants or were forced into that position.

The following list of deportees was listed recently in the National Genealogical Quarterly. Clifford Neal Smith did the research work. He is now deceased, but the executor of his estate gave permission for this list to be copied for the local publication.
