## Bellott(e) Bible Record

Ronald Kay received a phone call about a Bible that was found at a local antique dealer. The Bible was very old, having dates that went back to the Revolutionary War. It was a mystery about the former owner. Ron, thinking that he might someday find the family, and wanting it to be preserved, bought the Bible. The name of the owner, Peter E. Bellott, sounded like a French Huguenot name. Another surname listed was Lagard. The family's dates went into the Civil War era. Ron was curious as to which modern day family this Bible might belong. We have printed the dates and records from the Bible on the next four pages. Of interest are some dates of black children as well as the Bellott family. Near the end of the Bible was written at the bottom of the page: REA? Burriss (no dot on i),

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**Minutes January 2004**

The January meeting of the Anderson County chapter of the South Carolina Genealogical Society was held at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints on January 5 at 7 P.M. Fifteen members and guests were present. The meeting was called to order by the president, Juanita Garrison. Two visitors, Jim Winsness and Jay Wright, were introduced. Mr. Winsness told us about a ceremony which will be held at Lebanon Presbyterian Church in Abbeville County, commemorating the last surviving South Carolina Veteran of the Civil War. Mr. Wright, and Gene Schneider have been exploring and locating old cemeteries in a wildlife refuge near Toccoa, Georgia. The invocation was given by the chaplain, Lamar Gamble. The minutes of the November meeting were read and approved with the correction, changing "communities" to "churches."

In the absence of the treasurer, Ronald Kay, Linda Cushing reported a balance on December 1 of \$14,163.92. Checks amounting to \$490.18 were written and deposits of \$389 were made. An additional amount of \$106 was received, making a final balance of \$14,168.74. We have 30 paid members for 2004. Cost is \$13 (individual), \$16 (family) and \$10 (associate.)

Linda Cushing asked that anyone who has anything to be published please submit it to her.

Thelma Wilson reported that the church plans to open a family history room.

The speaker for February will be a member of the Greenville Library staff.

A lively discussion of research sources and information was then entered into by members. Linda Cushing gave several internet sites that provide valuable information.

President Garrison urged all members to organize their scattered notes and get them ready for publication. The meeting was adjourned.

**Minutes- February 2004**

The Anderson County Chapter of the South Carolina Genealogical Society met on Monday, February 2, at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, with 21 members and guests present. The meeting was called to order by the President, Juanita Garrison. The invocation was given by the Chaplain, Lamar Gamble. Visitors Dan and Lillie Love were introduced. They had also attended the October meeting.

Minutes of the January meeting were read and approved. The Treasurer reported a balance on hand of \$14,402.74. Dr. Charles Lee attended the state meeting as a representative of the chapter.

The President has been trying unsuccessfully to get in touch with Ludlow Porch.

Carl Ellison reported that he has put the records of the Welborn Mortuary on disks (1927-1942). Both black and white funerals were recorded, since there were no black mortuaries at the time. The average life span was 39 years and 11 months, and there were many stillborn babies. Of the 2,105 people who died, six were born in Ireland. We will sell them for \$12 each. The motion was approved. It was also moved and seconded that we sell the McDougald's disk for \$12. This was also approved.

The SC Death Index from 1915-1952 is available on the internet. ([www.scdhec.net/vr/di/default.htm](http://www.scdhec.net/vr/di/default.htm)).

Our guest speaker was Roger Wellington, South Carolina Room Supervisor at the Greenville County Library. He told us that he had grown up in Rochester, NY. He studied at Oxford University and earned a Master's Degree in Library Science at Emory University in Atlanta. He has lived in Greenville for 30 years. The SC Room in the new library is 2 ½ times the size of the old one. They have the 1930 census records for NC, SC, GA, TN, AL and FL. They also have the NC Confederate service records and the Revolutionary War pension and bounty lands applications. They have Oconee County estate records from 1868 to 1900. They have many family history records and folders, a listing of SC newspapers, Revolutionary War materials and cemetery records. A search of the catalog will locate these. The website is [www.greenvillelibrary.org](http://www.greenvillelibrary.org).

By using the website [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) and entering "SC State Archives," one can find information about land grants, state plats and military records. They have Moss's roster of SC Patriots, & a list of volunteers from 1784-1811 (between the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812.) The library can order from the LDS Library in Salt Lake City at \$3.50 a reel; borrowers can keep these a month. Records are available of black soldiers in WW I, a roster of SC men in WWII, a list of WWII and Korea veterans interred overseas, and death certificates from 1915-1952. The members enjoyed very much this very informative session.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Margaret Cole introduced a former student, Joe Hawkins and his wife, Sara, her sister Cynthia Campbell and her husband, Roger, and Anne Rack, as visitors. Also visiting was Bob Carlisle.

The minutes of the February meeting were read and approved. The Treasurer, Ron Kay, reported that we now have 75 paid members, and a balance on March 1 of \$14,300.75. Linda Cushing asked for articles and family information for the newsletter. The Dallas Public Library ordered copies of all of our books, and they have been sent. John Allen Morris is still collecting obituaries.

Carolyn Duncan reported that the Williamston Heritage Commission is holding a Heritage Festival on March 19 and 20. A dance will be held on Friday night at \$8 a couple. There will be a Lantern Tour on Saturday (\$5 ea.)

The Saluda Baptist Association is celebrating its 100th Anniversary with the publication of a book with sketches of all churches in the association (\$18 each). A motion was made and seconded to purchase one for the County Library. The motion was approved.

The cemetery listing for Crossroads (now Starr) Baptist Church is available online at rootsweb.com.

Phil Cheney introduced our speaker, Steven Tuttle from the SC Department of Archives and History. Steven has worked at the Archives since 1984 and is currently supervisor of Reference Services. He has a bachelor's degree in History from UNC-Asheville and a master's degree from the University of SC. He brought informational packets for each member, including a map guide for the Reference Room. They have 27,000 cubic feet with an estimated 35 million documents, including census records from 1890 to 1930, military records, and pension records from World War I and II and the Civil War.
