Linda Cushing will talk about Letters and Diaries at the April 4th meeting. She discovered a list of books called Women's Diaries and Letters of the South, a series edited by Carol Bleser for The University of South Carolina Press. It was a treasure trove of interesting journal and diary writers with links to our state. This list was printed in the new book, [A Faithful Heart: The Journals of Emmala Reed, 1865 and 1866](#), which currently is on sale at Hunter's Store in Pendleton and The Anderson Museum. Emmala Reed, daughter of Judge J.P. Reed, lived in Anderson, SC, and she wrote about the social lives of her family and friends during the last days of the War Between the States and the Reconstruction year that followed. Our hope is that by publishing the list of diaries and journals, it will create interest in some of these books.

### January 3, 2005 Minutes

Carolyn Duncan, president, called the meeting to order and Lamar Gamble gave the invocation. There were 36 present including the speaker, Joey Preston. The visitors were Ed and Patricia Chamblee, Joey Opperman, and Mary Ann Mills. Ron Kay gave the Treasurer's report that had a balance of \$14,533.05 on December 31, 2004. At the end of the meeting, the chapter had a total of 61 members that had paid for 2005 membership. Linda Cushing had a display of books and maps for sale. In addition to his report of plans to contact Forest Lawn Cemetery about using their records, Gene Schneider, cemetery chairman, made an announcement for the Anderson County Museum, that the book, *A Faithful Heart, Journals of Emmala Reed* was available for purchase.
