You will want to purchase this limited edition at a special pre-publication price of \$55.00. If you order after May 1, 2007, the price will be \$65.00. If the book is to be mailed, add \$8.00 per book. Purchase of a book is not a requirement, but is highly recommended Books with historical information like these are highly sought after and will be in demand for years to come. You should include a self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of your black and white photo that has name, address and phone number on the back, or have a copy of the photo that does not need to be returned. The extended deadline will allow us to edit information and get the proofs ready for the printer. HELP us please by getting your article to us posthaste.

Progress of the Anderson County Heritage Book

Shirley Galloway, book committee chairman, said that she had given workshops in every town in Anderson County. She was available to give talks at any type of meeting. She believed that everyone should know about the book by now. The committee is in need of photos of old buildings and would like to include visual artists. She reported that they had finished the \$1500 grant from the South Carolina Humanities. Wayne had forwarded funds that they had used so far and she asked that he be reimbursed. Jane Kowolski, financial agent for the grant, states that the fund had \$1,475.19; after reimbursing Wayne \$514.81 the balance would be \$960.38. Carolyn Duncan made a motion to reimburse Wayne for \$514.81. Sue Brewer seconded the motion and the motion was adopted. There is still time to submit a family story of 500 words and a picture. Or members could by a page of pictures for \$200, half a page for \$110, or quarter of a page for \$65.00 Pictures and memorials are welcome. We need articles about our way of life as it was then or as it is now, crop growing, mill working, cotton picking or just a story of your genealogy. No family sheets or fan-type diagrams are allowed. Just get your pen out and start to write. If you are worried about your article, someone in the Society could type it for you. We just need the information. If your family has been around for 100 years, you may use 1000 words and a picture. Military stories are 100 words and a picture. Time is running out.
