We are from Rhode Island and just made a trip to Georgia to engage in genealogy research on my mother's family. We stopped by Anderson today as that is where my mother (who is 88) was supposedly born. I had never been to your town and it is truly lovely.

I do have a couple of questions. My Mother's parents were married in LaGrange, Georgia but would make their way to Anderson in the early 1920s where my mother would be born. Her father worked in one of the mills in Anderson and I am assuming that they lived in one of the mill villages. They would have been residents in the mill village between 1921-1923 and I am wondering if there was a census taken of the mill village residents for tax purposes or otherwise that might have proven that they did live there. Ms McMullen, We found your grandmother and grandfather listed in the 1922-23 City Directory for Anderson County. Jas R and Morzel Daniel were living at 22 Wellington at Gluck Mills. He was a loom fixer.

Ms Duncan, Thank you so very much, Bingo, you found them. My mother is going to be so pleased to know that she was born in Anderson, SC and most likely in that same house. Thank you for your hard work to help me find this fact. You made a difference in our lives.
