ANDERSON - John Ronald Kay, 71, died Monday, January 10, 2011 at the Rainey Hospice House after a battle with colon cancer. He was born on August 30, 1939, in Anderson, and was the son of the late John Wayne and Annie Louise Norris Kay. His grandparents were John Sanford Palmer Kay and Ida Matilda Mann Kay (buried in Silver Brook Cemetery) and William Foster Norris and Lucy Eleanor Todd Norris (buried in Roberts Presbyterian Church Cemetery).

Mr. Kay was a 1957 graduate of Anderson Boys' High School and a 1961 graduate of Presbyterian College. He taught mathematics at several schools, including Belton-Honea Path High School and Westside High School, and retired after 25 years. He was reared a member of Midway Presbyterian Church, where he became a Deacon, and was a member of First Presbyterian Church, where he served as an usher. He was instrumental in the planning and carrying out of the Class Reunions for the Class of 1957 of the Anderson High Schools and was a longtime officer and member of the Anderson County Genealogical Society. He was a researcher for the Kay Family Association. Surviving are his twin brother, Dr. Wayne Donald Kay of Columbia; nephew, David McGinnis Kay, Esq. and his wife, Gabrielle N. K. Dean of Decatur, Ga., sister-in-law, Dr. Carol McGinnis Kay of Columbia; cousins, William Harold Kay and his wife, Mary, Miriam Lee Kay, Johnnye Kay Palmer and her husband, Bill, Marian Kay Parker, John Thomas Kay and his wife, Judy, Robert Gilmer Norris, Jr., Frank Anderson Norris and his wife, Martha, Daniel Norris Howell, and Dorothy Howell Cothran and husband, Harold.

Dr. Woods Spoke at January Meeting

At our January meeting at the Anderson County Library, Dr. Joyce Woods, history professor at Anderson University, spoke about her research on the school's history. The University celebrated its centennial this year. Founded as a female seminary in 1911, the school was named Johnson Female Seminary, after the famous South Carolinian educator, Dr. William E. Johnson. Female Seminaries were schools where young women were educated to teach.

In 1848, Dr. Johnson founded a school in Anderson for women situated on land that Boulevard Baptist Church now occupies. The school that at one time had 600 students, became Johnson University. In 1862, due to the War Between the States and the death of Dr. Johnson, the University closed. After the war, the building was headquarters for the Army and then, a Military Academy.

In 1910, money was raised and construction began in 1911 for a four-year teachers college.

Dr. Denmark became President in 1928 and during her tenure, the school became a junior college giving associate degrees. Denmark retired in 1953 and by that time, men were admitted as day students.

Dr. Woods made her program more interesting by showing pictures of the progress that the school has made in its building program and activities. Today the school is a four year accredited University conferring graduate and post-graduate degrees.

Frankie Atkins- February Speaker

Frankie Atkins, a member of the Cateechee Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, explained the research and application process to apply for membership in a lineage society. Mrs. Atkins, a certified DAR genealogist, was very knowledgeable about the society. Our club has a number of women who belong to such lineage societies.

Abbreviated Minutes for March 7, 2011

On Monday, March 7, 2011 at the Anderson County Library, there were 36 members and visitors present. President Bob Carlisle called the meeting to order and Dr. Carl Ellison gave the Invocation. The minutes were read and approved. Treasurer, Gary Farmer gave the treasury report. Announcements were made about the Civil War Roundtable and the Sons of Confederate memorial service to be held May 14, Old Pendleton District 100 Year Reunion to be held at the Southern Wesleyan University March 26, and 150th homecoming for Lebanon Baptist Church on March 27. Dr. Ellison said that he had scanned over 100 thousand searchable pages in the computer and asked members to bring in their records of Anderson County and South Carolina. Dr. Ellison assured members that the scanner would not damage their material.

President Carlisle introduced our speaker, chapter past president and garden columnist for The Independent, Juanita Garrison. Mrs. Garrison gave tips on researching and publishing family trees. With humor and the help of Rebecca Tinsley as *then* and Mary McAbee as *now*, Mrs. Garrison demonstrated how much easier the computer has made researching. She said the main things were enjoy what you're doing, be careful in note taking and record the source, get it done, print it and add pictures to make it real.
