We celebrate the sesquicentennial of the War Between the States because of its profound history on southern families. At our March meeting, enactors came to tell us more about the time and places. A list of our ancestors both Union and Confederate who fought in that Great War are memorialized and their names are printed in this issue. Do you wish you knew more about the War Between the States? ### **Abbreviated Minutes for April 4, 2011**

On Monday, April 4, 2011 at the Anderson County Library, there were 52 members and visitors present at the meeting on the Civil War. Jean Hoag gave out programs and Philip Cheney played music as everyone arrived. Reenactors Jamey Wentzky, Darlene Dowdy and Philip Cheney came dressed appropriately for the time period. Before starting the roll call, Darlene asked members to stand to honor their ancestors when she called their name. As Darlene called each name, she also included service information of the Confederate and one Union representative. After the roll call, a moment of silence was observed for those who sacrificed greatly for what they believed. Philip led everyone in singing period songs.

President Carlisle asked for someone to be the state representative, Shelby Lollis volunteered. Dr. Carl Ellison and his daughter, Diane, were putting the 1915 - 1923 Anderson death certificates into searchable files. Carol Penry is helping Carolyn get the records of the Anderson County Home ready to publish. David Bevill has donated his collection of Civil War books. President Carlisle thanked Carolyn for doing a great job. Ed Chamblee announced the June meeting will be at First Presbyterian Church. The meeting was adjourned. ### **Abbreviated Minutes for May 2, 2011**

There were 40 members and visitors present at the Anderson County Library to view Jamey Wentzky's collection of Civil War memorabilia on display before the meeting. President Bob Carlisle called the meeting to order and Dr. Carl Ellison gave the invocation. Dr. Julia Barnes, President of Belton Chapter, United Daughters of the Confederacy and her husband, Michael Barnes were the speakers. Both are very active in Civil War reenactments, cemetery observances for Civil War veterans and informative Civil War education programs for school students. Dr. Barnes used models Michael Barnes, Philip Cheney and Jamey Wentzky to explain the difference in their uniforms, noting that each state had a different uniform. With the help of Luanne Foster, Doris Dowdy and Shirley Phillips, Dr. Barnes demonstrated the layers of undergarments and the outer garments that women wore in the 1860s. Dr. Barnes was wearing a reproduction dress that matched one that her gr-gr-grandmother, Sarah Seaver Parker, was wearing in a photo. Philip Cheney afterwards played the banjo, singing and giving the history of each song.

Minutes were read and approved. There was no treasury report available.

Philip suggested the list of names on the April Roll Call be put into the minute records. They are to be included in the newsletter. A vote on cemetery signs was taken and approved.

President Carlisle recognized the visitors and congratulated Dr. Rich for receiving the Order of the Palmetto.

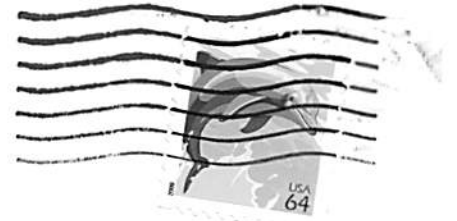

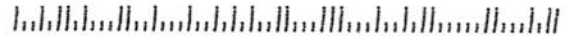
