(d) In the event that my son should not survive me, or after having survived me, should not survive my wife, then the payments of income from the trust to Allen University and Meharry Medical College shall commence following the death of my wife and the distribution of the corpus of the trust shall be made by the Trustee at the expiration of twenty-one (21) years from the death of my wife, or at such time as this trust might become executed by operation of law.

(e) If both my wife and son should predecease me, then the income from this trust shall be paid to Allen University and Meharry Medical College for a period of twenty-one years following my death with the distribution of the corpus to such ultimate beneficiaries to be made at the expiration of such period of twenty one years, or at such earlier date as this trust may become executed by operation of law.

ITEM IX: The provisions made in this Will for the benefit of my wife are expressly in lieu of dower and year's support.

ITEM X: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Wilhelmina White, Executrix, and the Citizens and Southern National Bank, a National Banking Association, Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, which appointment shall be deemed to include any bank or trust company into which the Citizens and Southern National Bank may hereafter be merged or consolidated.
