Therefore, I will and bequeath to Charlotte Bowen my wedding ring; to Eunice Bowen my iron frying pan and gold chain; to Dorothy Murdoch my glass pin with white gold around it' to Essie Garmon Manning my birthstone ring; to Hassie Garmon Shaw my signet ring; to Effie Plunkett House my yellow gold pin and silk quilt.

4th. I will and direct that My executrix and Executor shall divide my wearing apparel, bed clothes and linens to my step-children, my step-grandchildren and to my cousins, Essie Garmon Manning and Hassie Garmon Shaw, in an impartial way that each will have some remembrance of me.

Sth. I am owner of a certain real estate mortgage on real estate situated in the Barnes Station Community. I will and bequeath one-half interest in this to my step-son, Earle Murdoch, and will and direct that the other one-half interest be used by my Executrix and Executor in payment of any debts and expenses of last illness, funeral and for the monument. After these provisions are carried out I will and bequeath any residue jointly to my step-children, Earle Murdoch, Onie Murdoch, Jeanette Murdoch and Mrs. Gertrude M. Bowen. If the one-half interest in said real estate mortgage does not adequately provide for my debts, if any, any expenses of last illness, funeral and monument, I will and direct that the remainder of such obligations be charged against any interest that I may have in real estate.

6th. I will and devise to my step-son, Earle Murdoch, and to my step-daughters, Onie Murdoch, Jeannette Murdoch and Mrs. Gertrude M. Bowen all of my undivided interest in the David Murdoch tract of land situated on Rocky River and the J. D. Murdoch tract of land jointly to be theirs in fee simple absolute.

7th Having every confidence in my step-daughter, Onie Murdoch, and step-son, Earle Murdoch, I hereby nominate and appoint them Executrix and Executor of this my last Will and Testament, giving them full authority and power to do any and everything necessary to carry out the provisions of this my last Will and Testament.
