- (d) To pay, collect, defer, extend, adjust, settle, arbitrate, or compromise any claim by or against me or my Estate.
- (e) To vote in person or by proxy in respect to all securities belonging to my Estate, to exchange or surrender securities; to pay all assessments, subscriptions, and other sums for the protection of securities; to exercise any options or conversion privileges or subscription rights with respect thereto; and generally to exercise all the powers and rights (whether hereinabove

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enumerated or not) as are or may be lawfully exercised by persons holding sificilar property in their own right.

- (f) To take and hold in his own name, as Executor, any property or securities coming into his hands as Executor.
- (g) To make reasonable determinations whether any money or other property, including but not limited to, liquidating, or other dividends, or the proceeds of any rights or privileges coming into his hands should be treated as principal or income, or partly principal and partly income; and to determine whether any distribution, disbursements, and expenses, shall be charged against principal or income, or partly against principal and partly against income.

N. Killingsworth and Thomas Bruce be given the privilege of paying for some item of my personal belongings, pay to my Executrix a reasonable fee for chosen item to go for my debts.
- 8. I will, devise and bequeath the rest, residue and remainder of my property of whatsoever kind and wheresee situate real and person to my sister, Bessie Killingsworth Bruce with request that the house and lot be kept till such time that the Maximum price be received that a trust fund be established for Hilda Bruce at the death of my sister, Bessie Bruce.
- 9. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my sister Bessie K. Bruce, Executrix of this my last Will and Testament without bond.
