



provided however, that no one of them shall be allowed to choose articles whose appraised value shall exceed the proportionate share of the total appraised value of all my furniture, household furnishings, personal effects, jewelry and clothing,

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to which such person shall be entitled, unless the other surviving members of this group shall consent thereto in writing.

This bequest shall lapse as to any of said furniture, household furnishings, personal effects, jewelry and clothing which is not selected by the surviving members of this group within a time which is in the sole discretion of my Executor deemed to be reasonable, and all articles which have not been selected shall be sold by my Executor as soon as conveniently can be done and the proceeds of such sale shall be placed in the residue of my estate.

ARTICLE II

A. I give, devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property of whatever name and nature wherever situated, including the proceeds of any insurance policies payable for the benefit of my estate, payable to my estate, or payable to me, my executors, administrators, or assigns, and including all property over which I may have any power of appointment, to that person or those persons who are at the time of my death serving as the trustees under a certain instrument of trust heretofore executed by me on July 20^{-H} , 1973, and entitled the "VIRGINIA R. 5. To collect rents and other proceeds from real estate, pay all carrying charges thereon and make such repairs thereto as they may deem proper without the necessity of obtaining leave of any court.

6. To delegate discretionary powers to agents, remunerate them and pay their expenses.

7. With respect to any property distributable to a minor hereunder, to be fully protected and discharged by delivery of such property to the minor or his guardian or blood relative.

8. In order to facilitate administration of my estate plan, I give to my executor full power to make sale of my probate assets to the trustees from time to time serving under said VIRGINIA R.
