

RAINES, and LINDA GAIL HADDON, in equal shares, share and share alike, to be theirs in fee simple, with children of a predeceased child to take the share of the parent. I would further hope and desire that my wife, children, and son-in-laws would use my tools and equipment jointly.

ITEM VIII. In the event that one of my children or their representatives does not wish to keep their share of the property, neither real or personal, hereinabove devised to them, then in that event they are to give the remaining children the first option to purchase said property at the current fair market value based on an appraisal of three (3) people, one of which to be appointed by my Executor, the other to be appointed by my Executorix, and the remaining one to be appointed jointly by my Executor and Executrix.

ITEM IX. I hereby give my hereinafter named Exeuctor and Executrix a full and complete power to convey to any one of my four daughters a tract of land of ten (10) acres or less, for the purpose of building a house for their principal residence with said conveyance being considered as part of their share of my entire estate.

ITEM X. I hereby name, nominate, constitute and appoint my daughter, PATRICIA LOUISE HADDON COCKFIELD, and my son-in-law, L. HENRY RAINES, the Executrix and Executor respectively of this my Last Will and Testament, giving and granting unto them full and complete power to sell or convey any and all of my property and to do anything else necessary to carry out the terms of this my Last Will and Testament, and I hereby direct that they both serve without bond.


