



Fourth: I give, devise and bequest the balance of my property whether real, personal or mixed, of every kind and description wherescever situated, which I may own at the time of my decease to my wife, Sarah Walker Moore, absolutely and in fee simple; but should my wife, Sarah Walker Moore, predecease me or should we die in a common accident or disaster, then and in either event, I will and bequest the balance of my Estate real, personal or mixed to be sold and placed in a Building and Loan Company to be selected by my Executor, and what ever part is necessary of this fund is to be used for a College Education for Ennet Herbital Moore, Jr., and Cyndia E. Moore, and they are to select the College of their choice, and at the completion of their College Education the balance of money that is left in the Building and Loan Company is to be equally divided between my children James Herbert Moore, Jr., Wayland D. Moore, Cyndia E. Moore, Frankie M. Snipes, and Patsy M. Bannister.

Fifth: I nominate constitute and appoint my with Sarah Salker Moore Executrix of this my last will and testiment, never specifically confering upon her such authority as is necessary to carry out the provisions of this will, and she is to serve without bond; but should my wife. Sarah Walker Moore, predecess me, or for any reason fail to qualify as Executrix under this will, or should we die in a common accident or disaster, then and in either event. I nominate, constitute and appoint Wayland D. Moore, Executor without bond of this my last will and testament and I hereby confer on him all of the powers related hereinabove.
